SPLIT CANE RODS

If there ever was a teary eyed moment within the life of fly fisherman, it's casting a size 16 PMD onto a spring fed creek, with the heritage of a split cane fly rod. Mario Wojnicki has been building Scott cane rods with his earned reputation of one of the worlds most skilled bamboo rod makers. By hand, Mario splits, flames, and planes the culms of bamboo. He then lathes and polishes his own reel seat inserts from fine hardwoods, and crafts fittings from nickel silver. The guides are then wrapped in classic translucent silk thread, and uniquely shaped cork grips are hand sanded to perfection. Only the truly heart tugged need apply.
