Three Pieces and Extra Tip with Bamboo Tip Case

Mr. Hawes' personal experience in tournament casting has taught him what the tournament caster needs for record making. Unusual power and speed will be found in all his rods for this class of work. In dry fly fishing it is necessary to keep the fly in the air to keep it dry. Consequently, you need a powerful rod. For this style of fishing, Hawes' rods are particularly suited owing to their unusual retrieving power. The 4¼ to 5¼ ounce rods are the weights most generally used for dry fly fishing. They

have solid cork grips, snake guides and metal reel seats.

CROSS RODS

The Cross rod is double built. Two strips of cane are cemented together, the inside of one strip to the enamel of the other strip, thus making a lamination of the very finest and toughest material. Six triangular strips cut from this laminated cane make a rod that has power in every fibre; the pithy part of the cane is completely eliminated. Rods made in this manner weigh less, for their strength will stand more abuse, and will cast better. It is almost impossible to set them under the most adverse conditions. The Cross rod is the "last word" in fine rod making. They are made of extra Tonkin cane, 12 strips built into six double sections. Fly rod tips, however, are single built; their diameter is so small that all the pith or soft wood is eliminated in planing. Cross rods are not made in Tournament models; they are first, last and all the time fishing rods. All Cross fly rods are in three joints with extra tip, furnished with heavy duck bag, and aluminum case of new design for entire rod. Can be produced in agate or
