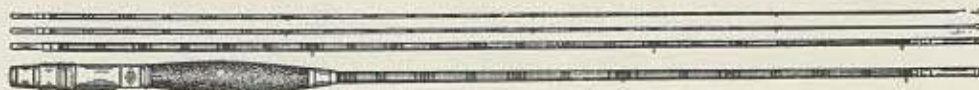

HEXAGON SPLIT BAMBOO FLY RODS

Split African Steel Cane Rods



No. 2353

No. 2353.—Made from selected African steel cane, 6 strips cemented together, as in a split bamboo rod, and rounded. This is a strong fibre rod with a beautiful action. Fly or trout rod, three-piece with extra tip, silk whipped at close intervals, nickel mountings, snake guides, locking reel seat below hand, cork grasp, finished with flowing varnish. Lengths 8¼, 8½, 9, 9½ and 10 feet; weights 5, 5½, 6½ and 7 oz. In flannel covered form and flannel bag----- Each, \$ 5.00

No. 2753.—Bait rod with reel above hand; 7½ to 10 feet; weight 7½ to 8½ oz.; otherwise same as 2353----- Each, 5.00

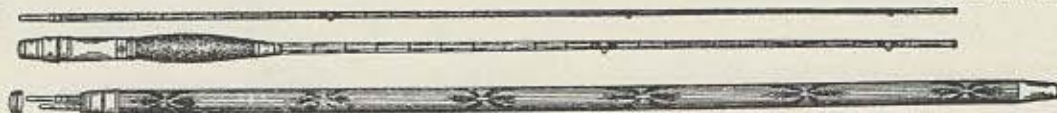
No. 2354.—Three-piece, split African steel cane fly rod with extra tip, full nickel mountings, hand welted ferrules, cork grasp, locking reel seat below hand, closely whipped in red and green silk, with broad solid green winds on butt and second joint, snake ring guides. Same length and weight as 2353. Put up in velvet covered form and flannel bag----- Each, 6.00

¶ Sometimes we are asked "What is African Steel Cane?" African Steel Cane is a light colored, close grained, strong fibered variety of bamboo. Has great tensile strength and much elasticity, making a very durable rod. The rounding process gives the rod a better action.

Combined Split Bamboo Fly Rod and Landing Net.

No. 2338.—To meet the demand for a rod and net combined, for stream or for boat fishing, we have brought out this new rod. The net bow is collapsible, 11¼ x 13½ in., fitted with

tanned landing net, and screws on the handle, which is 42 inches long and contains both tips. The rod is made from good quality split bamboo, three pieces and extra tip. Closely wound with light green silk. A very popular novelty—Each, \$6.00

This rod is made especially for the fisherman wishing a very light, strong rod. Locking reel seat. 8¼-foot weighs 3¾ oz.; 9-foot, 4⅛ oz. Put up with extra tip in velvet covered form and flannel bag----- Each, \$ 6.00

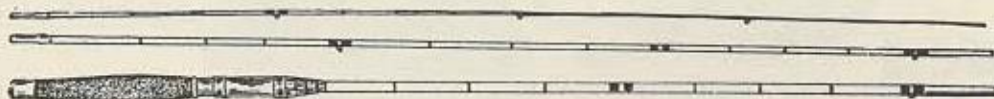

- No. 2713.—Three-piece, split bamboo bait or bass rod with extra tip, solid nickel mountings, standing ring guides, extra winds in red and black, cork grasp, reel seat above hand. Length 7, 7½, 8½, 9, 9½ and 10 feet; weight 7½ to 11 oz. In wood frame and cloth bag..... Each \$ 1.75



- No. 2712.—Three-piece, split bamboo bait or bass rod, with extra tip, solid nickel mountings and standing ring guides, red windings, cork grasp, reel seat above hand. Length 7, 7½, 8, 8½, 9 and 10 feet; weight 7½ to 11 oz. In wood form and cloth bag..... Each, \$ 1.25
No. 2711.—Same as 2712, with ebonized wood grasp. In wood form and cloth bag..... Each, 1.00

A WORD ABOUT LANCEWOOD

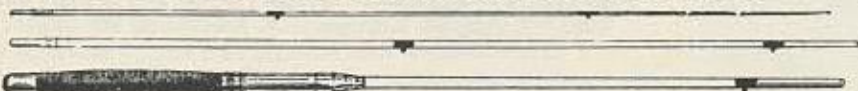
For nearly a century fishing rods of highest grade have been made from Lancewood. Other kinds of wood and bamboo have been tried, but many expert fishermen, both in this country and England, still cling to the Lancewood rods as being the strongest, most durable and best, both for fly casting or bait fishing.

Because of its close, straight grain, its springy, tenacious fibre and great strength, Lancewood still maintains its place as one of the best materials for fishing rod manufactured.

The best Lancewood grows in Cuba, in forests back some distance from the coast. During the past few years, especially during the Cuban revolution and the Spanish war, this was so difficult to procure that many imitations have been used and placed on the market. A certain prejudice against the genuine has arisen, from the use of these imitations, as they in all cases have been far inferior to the genuine.

We put up all our Lancewood Rods regularly in cloth bags, being more compact and convenient to carry. Forms will be supplied when ordered, at the following prices:

No. 08711.—Imitation Lancewood, 8½ to 10 feet bait rod, three-piece, standing guides, nickel mountings, reel seat above hand, imitation celluloid grasp. Good rod for boat fishing. In cloth partitioned bag..... Each, .85
