## Orvis Rods

Fishing rods like most other goods have a wide range as to value, and yet, a high price does not necessarily mean superior quality. The construction of a properly balanced rod for fly casting is a work of art; the maker should be an expert fly fisher and a man of mechanical accuracy. The bamboo must be selected with conscientious care as there is a great difference in the strength of stock. In the Orvis rods only the very best is used as the aim is for quality rather than quantity, and we are frank in saying that we do not believe a better rod can be produced even if the makers ask \$25 or even \$30. Strength and ease of casting can be proven by practical test in use. Just try one or ask any angler who has used an Orvis rod what he thinks of their merits.

All rods are made hexagonal, in three pieces, two joints; have an extra tip and solid cork handles. They are put up in cloth partition sack and round wood rod case with screw top.

### ORVIS HAND-MADE SPLIT BAMBOO FLY RODS, FINEST QUALITY, \$15.00

Made in three pieces, has two tips, sack and Orvis round wood rod case. German silver mountings with banded ferrules. Snake guides. Orvis patent metal reel seat, and whipped with silk. These rods are very finely finished with solid cork hand pieces that will not loosen, crack or come off.
