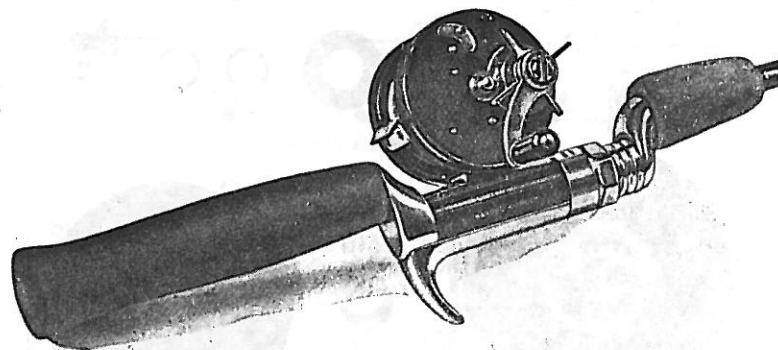

We designed and produced this outfit to meet the requirements of "Jock Scott," the well-known angling author and coach. As a result of experience gained while teaching pupils to fish a bait, he found that the chief drawbacks to spinning, as usually practised in this country, were:

1. The tendency for a beginner to make inaccurate casts until he or she had served a comparatively long apprenticeship.
2. The overrunning question.
3. The necessity sometimes found for making long casts with a very light bait; casts which, when salmon fishing with a line of 6 lb. or greater breaking strain, were beyond the capacity of a fixed-spool reel, except the "Altex" No. 3.
4. The bugbear of kinked lines.
5. The necessity—in the case of a fixed-spool reel—of keeping the spool absolutely full of line. Should the end become worn, it is necessary to cut off the worn portion and add backing to fill the spool.
6. The necessity for using swivels, leads and/or anti-kink discs on the trace.
7. The difficulty of controlling the depth at which the bait swims.
8. The tendency of certain baits to fish "nose up", thereby both looking unnatural and more readily fouling snags.
9. The difficulty found, in some designs of light casting reel, in controlling a hooked fish.

As a result of experiments made in conjunction with "Jock Scott", and covering many months, we at length evolved the "Hardy-Jock Scott Outfit", which he has permitted us to name as above.

The Outfit opens up a new field to the light spinner for salmon, trout and pike. The salmon fisher, in particular, will find the new method to be both deadly and as fascinating as the greased line.

Briefly, the advantages derived from the new method are:

A light bait can be cast with deadly accuracy to very great distances, thus following the very successful precept "fine and far off". During some recent tests, and using a 9 lb. breaking strain line under fishing conditions, the following distances were readily attained: 2 drams bait, 25-27 yards; 4 drams bait, 35 yards; 6 drams bait, 50 yards; $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. bait, 60 yards.

The reel has a line capacity of 100 yards of 6 lb. "Cero" line over a split cork arbour. It is, however, by no means confined to the use of such fine lines. By removing the arbour, 100 yards of 9 lb. "Cero" line may be used, and the reel thereby rendered suitable for fishing in stronger water. The 9 lb. line provides a generous margin of safety when playing heavy salmon or pike, and for casting and fishing large baits in the spring months.

A slipping clutch, readily adjustable while a fish is being played, is included in the specification of the reel.

The reel is controlled during the cast by a special design of centrifugal governor which, while allowing maximum distance, absolutely prevents overruns.

The line is never kinked, either by the reel or by the bait, therefore no swivels, leads or discs—which in clear water might distract a fish's attention from the bait—are needed; and the life of the line is very greatly prolonged.

The rod is balanced to give easy and effortless casting combined with great accuracy, hooking power and control over a hooked fish. It will cast a bait with a mere flick of the wrist; while its action has been designed in accordance with the strength of the lines employed and the size of the treble hooks fitted to the baits, so providing an absolutely harmoniously balanced outfit, capable of striking and playing a fish with the greatest possible efficiency.

The baits swim with a natural motion resembling that of a small fish. Many important features are included in their design, and which are exclusive to the "Hardy-Jock Scott" baits. They can be fished at differing depths and with varying swim or "wiggle". The angler may thus vary his tactics in accordance with the temperature, height and clearness of the water, or pace of the stream.

In short, the new method provides advantages not previously offered by any spinning outfit, while at the same time eliminating a number of drawbacks inherent in the older methods; and it can be applied with equal success from the early spring to the close of the season.

ADVANTAGES

Extremely accurate casting. No "pulled" casts, with possible loss of tackle.

No overrunning.

No guiding the line with the fingers.

No kinking of lines, either by reel or bait.

Complete control of bait while casting and fishing.

Complete and easy control of hooked fish.

No necessity for keeping drum completely full of line, with consequent waste of time when fish are taking.

The bait may be fished as slowly as desired without fouling the bottom in water of any depth.

Conversely, the bait may be fished as rapidly as is deemed desirable without "cutting".

Lines of adequate strength for killing salmon may be used without sacrificing distance.

There is no loose line to catch anywhere in a wind.

Petty annoyances are entirely absent.

The baits may be fished at any depth desired.

When salmon fishing in summer, the bait may be fished almost on the surface and each rise actually seen, as in greased-line fishing.

Long casting with a light bait is easily accomplished. Weights of 2 drams can be cast 25 to 27 yards.

No swivels or leads are required on the trace.

The outfit is extremely light, and can be used all day without fatigue.

"HARDY-JOCK SCOTT" ROD

This dainty little weapon is built of "Palakona" (Regd. Trade Mark) split bamboo, and measures 5 feet 6 inches in length. Two tops are provided, fitting into the one handle. These tops are designed to cast respectively $\frac{1}{4}$ oz. and $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. baits, and they are fitted throughout with encased agate rings, carefully spaced so as to ensure the best results, both when casting and playing a fish. The action is so regulated that, when using the larger baits, which are fitted with No. 7 trebles, and a 9 lb. line together with the $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. top, certain penetration of the hook is assured when striking a fish. So likewise in the case of the $\frac{1}{4}$ oz. top and smaller baits fitted with No. 9 hooks proper penetration is provided, together with a suitable action for use with a 6 lb. line. The 6 lb. line may, of course, be used with the $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. top, provided that the clutch on the reel is not set too stiffly.

We recommend the use of the $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. top for casting $\frac{3}{8}$ oz. and $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. baits, reserving the $\frac{1}{4}$ oz. top for use with the lightest baits and lines in low and clear water.

The handle is cranked and provided with back and front cork grips; the forward grip being a great convenience when playing a fish. The cranked handle eliminates friction between the line and the butt ring, and also allows the thumb to rest upon the reel in a natural and comfortable manner.

An aluminium trigger is provided, round which the forefinger is placed when casting to ensure a powerful grip. As some anglers do not like the trigger, or wish to change their grip during the day, it is made instantly detachable. Upon one end of the trigger is a peg fitting into a hole in the crank, where it is locked by the "Screw-Grip" reel fitting. These reel fittings are our standard type with hexagonal screw-down ring. A spanner is provided.

The rod complete weighs 7 ounces 2 drams when the $\frac{1}{4}$ oz. top is in use; and 7 ounces 3 drams with the $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. top. It is supplied in a proofed cloth case with pockets to hold the handle, stopper and spanner, and with an aluminium tube protector to carry the tops.
