2. Solid core construction prevents waterlogging, ensures durability.
3. Ultra smooth finish, permanently lubricated with special lifetime lubricant, ensures easy swift 'shooting'. Line is supple and responsive, does not crack, strip or deteriorate, requires no drying or dressing.
4. Weight is scientifically distributed ensuring perfect 'unrolling' of line, maximum ease of casting combined with distance, accuracy and delicate presentation.

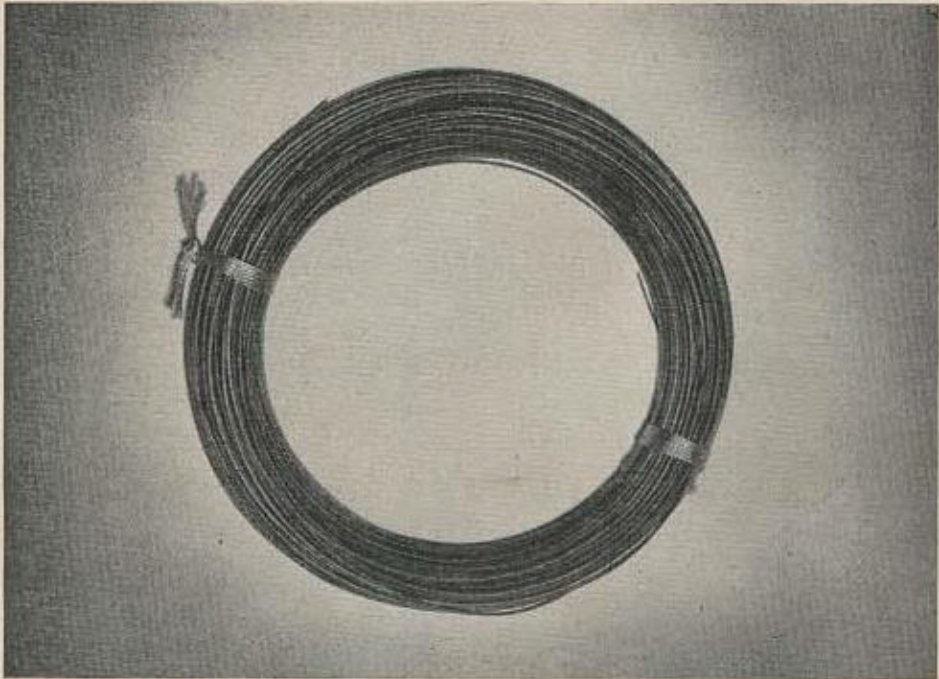
EXPLANATION OF AFTM NUMBERS

Our fly lines, wherever possible, are classified by what are known as AFTM Standards, e.g. # 7. These numbers classify the line by the actual weight of the first 30 feet of taper (excluding the level point), that is to say the average casting length. By this means it is possible to ascertain the actual weight of line that a rod will have to cast, regardless of taper, diameter etc., when an average casting length is used. Our fly rods are similarly marked with AFTM Numbers, so that for any of our fly rods a line may be selected of the AFTM Number shown on the rod and you can be sure that the line will correctly balance the rod. AFTM Standards cover a wide range of weights, and are indicated by figures from 1 to 12, always preceded by the symbol '#—e.g. # 5, # 8 etc.

CARE OF LINE

WATERPROOF FLY LINES

After use, lines should always be taken off the reel and left on drier or in loose coil until thoroughly dry. They should not be rewound on the reel until required for fishing.

THE 'FILIP'

The Original Balanced or Forward Tapered Fly Line

Highest quality waterproof silk.

The 'Filip' fly line is a happy combination of certain features adapted from both tournament and ordinary double-taper fly lines and so named from the 'filip' it gives to casting.

The 'Filip' is in fact an anticipation by many years of the lines now termed 'balanced', and was designed by the late Mr. J. J. Hardy as long ago as 1901. Its make-up and the distribution of its weights are so arranged that longer casts can be made and the 'following' line more smoothly 'shot'.

The turnover or finish of the forward line and gut-cast will retain sufficient impetus to propel the fly accurately to the selected spot and, most essential of all, you will find that the fly falls lightly.

The 'Filip' line was designed to help anglers to cast better, i.e. with greater accuracy, and to obtain greater distances without employing greater energy or using heavier rods and lines. By better casting the angler develops that most priceless of all the fisherman's assets—confidence.

THE 'COROLENE' FLY LINE

Double tapered or Forward tapered

Braided of 'Terylene' Polyester yarn and dressed with a revolutionary new process. The 'Corolene' is soft, pliant and shoots easily; yet will neither rot, become tacky, nor will the dressing strip from the line. The dressing is such that the line does not need drying after use though it is not advisable to leave a wet line on a reel as the reel may suffer from the effects of moisture.
