Designing a Hardy carbon fibre blank

To make the highest quality rod blank it is necessary to start with the highest quality materials. At our Alnwick factory we use only the highest specification carbon fibre cloth, irrespective of cost. The cloth is graded according to its tensile strength, the type of resin used to hold the fibres together and its elasticity, known as 'elastic modulus'. These qualities affect the action of a rod and its ability to withstand breakage. The rod taper is critical to its action.

The skill in designing a prototype rod blank therefore lies in selecting just the right modulus carbon fibre cloth and in creating exactly the right taper to achieve the desired rod action. In our new generation of multi-modulus rods we have taken the art of rod design one stage further by using different grades of carbon fibre cloth within the same rod in order to refine the action. We now use advanced computer based analysis to help our design experts obtain the necessary feel.

Bamboo rods

The Palakona trade name for Hardy bamboo rods was first registered on 13th June 1902. The rod is made from six sections of the finest Kwantung bamboo that have been gently roasted to reduce moisture content. In 1925, Laurence Robert Hardy, known by colleagues and friends as LR, invented a bamboo cutting machine capable of creating a perfect angle and taper on each split-bamboo section.

It allowed the sections to be glued together with the greatest accuracy to form a perfect hexagon. The highly skilled craft of making a Palakona rod has changed little over time, except that we no longer roast our bamboo in the ovens of the local bakery as they did in those early days.





The Palakona is the classic split-bamboo rod, ideal for fishing with dry fly or nymph on small rivers and streams. Its heritage dates back to 1882 when William and John Hardy invented 'an improved system for building fishing rods in hexagonal form'. Since then we have further improved the methods and materials used in the construction of the Palakona, making it even better.

The rods are handmade from the finest bamboo from Kwantung in China. Three standard sizes are available from 6' to 7'2". They are of 2 piece construction and come with a spare top section so each top section can be rested on alternate days. Every detail is of the highest quality. The suction joints, reel fittings and butt caps are made from polished aluminium; the rod stopper is of polished rosewood and cork, and the hard chrome snake rings are secured with crimson tippings. However, any Palakona can be custom-made to order up to 9' in length to your own specification.

Over the years the House of Hardy has received orders from anglers the worldover, as well as the patronage of the crowned heads of Europe. The company has been honoured with no less than ten Royal Warrants of Appointment during its 127 years of existence.

Supplying royalty has not always been without risk. When the Queen of Italy, an accomplished fisherwoman, ordered four Hardy fishing rods in April 1918, every effort was made to deliver the rods across war-torn Europe before the end of the fishing season. Fortunately, she received the rods in perfect condition within two months.
