This emblem heralds a new era for the British angler. Noris Shakespeare has created the FISH HAWK brand name for a new series of products with one essential feature in common: their design was undertaken as a completely scientific operation. They are the result of genuine scientific research.

Under this brand, we offer a new series of fly rods, a new range of fly lines

and a new high-performance monofilament nylon.

The Fish-hawk is another name for the Osprey—that beautiful large bird of prey which once bred freely in the British Isles, then disappeared from our shores, but has recently returned to Loch Garten, in Inverness-shire, where a pair of the birds have raised several successive broods. Their prey is largely restricted to perch and small pike, so their presence in that part of the country is beneficial rather than otherwise. Above all, though, they provide a magnificent, exciting spectacle—as is evidenced by the thousands of visitors who have peered at them through long-range field-glasses in the Warden's hut (and who have been glad to make their contribution to Wild-Life Conservation in gratitude for the sight!)

This is one reason why Noris Shakespeare has chosen the "Fish-Hawk" trademark for these new products. Certainly the fly rods in particular will stand out, for anglers, for their distinguished—indeed, beautiful—finish and

appearance.

However, that is by no means the only quality which distinguishes the "Fish-Hawk" rods. The basic raw material chosen for them is tonkin cane—

but with entirely new processes applied to it.

In tonkin cane, the long tough fibres are bonded with pectin. The traditional heat-treatment of the cane solidifies the pectin, giving to it a tough, elastic consistency. From this material, provided the heat-treatment is carefully controlled, a very good fishing rod can be made. Even so, the traditional method has its limitations. These arise from the fact that, due to the concentration of the fibres at and near the surface of the tonkin pole, it is only in these areas that the toughening is complete.

Now, though, Noris Shakespeare is using an absolutely new process, developed originally to reinforce timber required to undergo exceptional stresses without distortion. Under the process, synthetic resins are injected deep into the voids between the cane fibres, achieving an unprecedented depth of penetration. This, with the natural pectin, forms a hard, unified structure of unrivalled strength, resilience and resistance to moisture-absorption. The product is then sealed in translucent polyurethane, producing the only finish which matches the unprecedented qualities of the sub-structure. ("Flash", incidentally, is largely eliminated).

In our experience, no synthetic substance for rod rings has yet been made available which is equal to agate in terms of performance and appearance. Accordingly, we have reintroduced genuine agate butt and end rings for the "Fish-Hawk" rods. Intermediate rings are heavily chromed and the winch fittings are finished in dull gun-barrel black.

In plain language, these are the finest, strongest and most handsome fishing

rods ever seen in Britain. (See colour plate, page 64).

The 9 ft. version is suitable for bank or boat fishing, The 9½ ft. is for reservoir bank fishing and sea-trouting. The 10 ft. is a very powerful rod indeed, suitable only for men of exceptional physique. It is equal to salmon fishing on small rivers.

All three rods have screw reel fittings, chromed bridge rings, minimum whippings, partitioned bags and rigid vinyl cases.




