





For the convenience of those who are still confused by "breaking strains" or micrometer readings as opposed to the more familiar "x" measurement used for so long with gut, we give below a table comparing the thickness with the old gut measurement. It should be remembered, however, that at a given thickness nylon is considerably stronger than gut, so that for a required strength finer nylon can be used.

#### Platil.

These German monofilament lines are well in advance of anything yet known. Perfectly round, smooth and pliable, and with a higher breaking strain, size for size, than any other. The 'stretch' is greatly reduced, and a non-flash water finish makes the line as nearly invisible as humanly possible. Packed in 4 x 25yd. spools, 50yd. spools or 100yd. spools. Diameter slightly less for corresponding breaking strain than Racine below.

Spider or hackled flies are excellent for clear water fishing, in fact, many anglers use them with great success throughout the whole season. In the spring months, flies dressed on sizes 2 and 3 hooks are best, but for the summer fishing, sizes 0 and 1 have a great advantage. Always remember, the size of the fly should be in accordance with the size and condition of the water.

There has always tended to be confusion between the "Old" and "New" scales of hook sizes, so we give below the conversion table. Unfortunately a few tackle makers persist in "converting" at a different stage to the rest, so for the convenience of our customers we have illustrated the principal types of hook in their actual sizes. 
