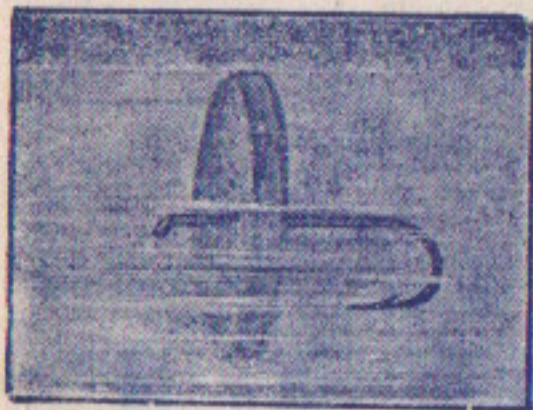

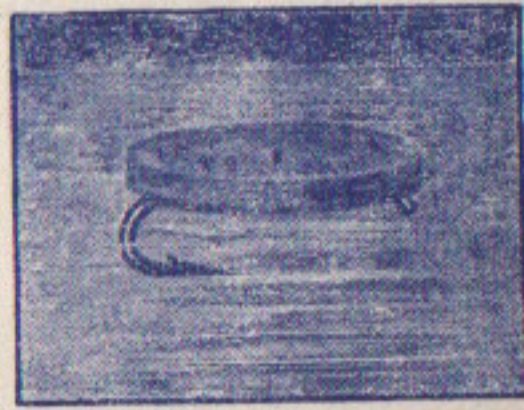
THE BEST DRY FLY

The disc attached to the hook represents the hackle or dressing. The disc on the left shows the position and relationship of hackle to hook in the usual method of fly dressing. No. 1001 ESKDALE.—Salmon Fly Rod. Length, 13 ft. 9 ins. Built of specially selected split Tonkin cane, in three pieces with two tops. We recommend this rod as being more powerful than any other of the same weight. Extra long double-hand cork grasp, screw grip reel fittings, agate butt and end, and hardened stainless steel intermediate rings. Lockfast joints with Martin secure anti-clockwise thread. Closely whipped and superbly finished. Supplied, with stoppers, in a divisioned rod cover and recommended for use with $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Thistle reel (See Page 11).

No. 1017. DEE light salmon fly rod, double handed, 11 feet, three pieces, weight $11\frac{1}{2}$ ozs. Developed for greased line fishing where the fish may be on the heavy side. Although fitted with double-handed grip of bung cork its light weight makes it possible for this rod to be used single-handed. An ideal rod for the smaller rivers.

No. 1018. EDEN, greased line salmon fly rod. 11 feet 3 ins., three pieces, weight $11\frac{1}{2}$ ozs. For the angler who prefers extreme lightness, yet expects to hook big sea trout and salmon, the "Eden" is a first choice. It is a single-handed rod with an extremely pleasant action, yet, thanks to the resilient strength of its tubular steel it has all the power needed to handle heavy fish.

No. 1019. LOCH, Sea trout fly rod. 10 feet, three pieces, weight $7\frac{3}{4}$ ozs. Designed and developed primarily for trout and sea trout fishing in waters which require a rod stronger than the usual trout fly rod. This powerful but light rod is fitted with best quality reinforced serrated ferrules, duralumin reel fittings, agate top and butt rings and bridge intermediates. Recommended for use with a 4 inch Beaudex reel and No. 4 double tapered line.

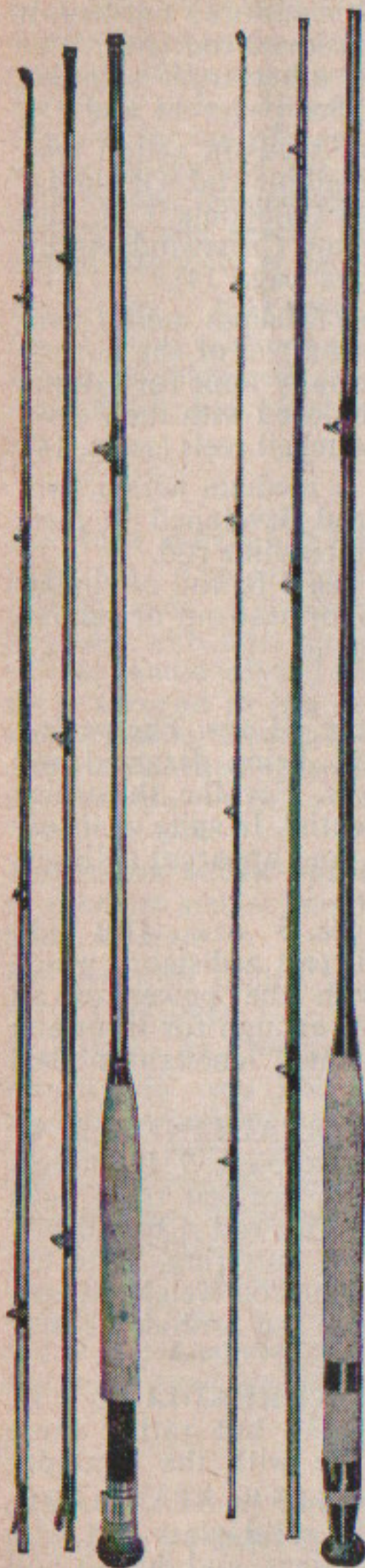
No. 1026a. "MARTOGLAS" THISTLE. Best quality 9 ft. three-piece trout fly rod, combining all the characteristics of tubular glass with the superb fittings of our Thistle cane rods. Screw grip reel fittings, lock-fast joints with Martin secure anti-clockwise thread, agate top and butt rings and bridge intermediates. Weight 6½ ozs. Recommended for use with 3½ in. Beaudex Reel and a No. 2 Double Tapered Line.

No. 1027a. "MARTOGLAS" SEATROUT. Best quality 10 ft. 6 in. three-piece fly rod specially developed for casting a long line, and handling a heavy fish. This rod is fitted with reinforced and serrated ferrules, screw grip reel fittings, agate butt and end rings, and bridge intermediates. Recommended for use with a 3½ in. Thistle Reel and a No. 4 double tapered line.

THREADLINE RODS : Built Cane

No. 1031. CALEDONIA 3 lb. Light action two-piece 7 ft. trout casting rod. A highest grade split cane rod with adjustable aluminium reel fittings and reinforced and serrated ferrules. This rod is fitted with a large offset Agite butt ring, Agite end ring and steel hoop intermediates. Closely whipped and beautifully finished, it is supplied with stopper and divisioned rod cover. For use with Ambidex No. 1, and other trout spinning reels. (See pages 14 and 15).

No. 1032. CALEDONIA 5 lb. Medium action two-piece 7 ft. seatrout or grilse threadline rod. Of similar finish but stouter build than the Caledonia 3 lb., this rod should be used with the Felton Crosswind, Ambidex No. 2 or Mitchell Reels (see page 14).

No. 1033. CALEDONIA 7 lb. Medium action two-piece 8 ft. grilse or salmon casting rod of the normal Caledonia finish, this rod is specially built for salmon threadline angling and should be used with the Felton Crosswind, Ambidex No. 2 or Mitchell reels (see p. 14).

No. 1034. STANDARD 5 lb. A medium action two-piece 7 ft. trout or seatrout rod developed to meet the demand for an inexpensive threadline rod.

No. 1035. STANDARD 7 lb. An 8 ft. rod of similar finish to the 1034 but designed for seatrout or salmon angling.

STEEL

No. 1036. ELAN, 7 ft., two-piece, 4½ ozs. The perfect rod for threadline trout fishing, being designed and developed for no other purpose. For the threadline enthusiast, the "Elan" is an essential. In spite of its extremely light weight of 4½ ozs. and apparent delicacy, it is a rod of surprising power.

No. 1037. ROSS, 7 ft., two-piece, 5 ozs. This light single-handed spinning rod will cast a distance which surprises those unfamiliar with the power of an "Apollo". Light and responsive enough for trout and seatrout, the "Ross" is still "man" enough to deal with salmon.

No. 1038. "MARTOGLAS" THREADLINE 5 lb. An extremely light but powerful two-piece 7 ft. hollow glass rod capable of casting the heaviest trout baits and handling the best of trout. This rod is beautifully finished and is fitted with offset butt ring, agite top ring and bridge intermediates. The rod weighs 4¾ ozs. and is recommended for use with the Ambidex No. 1, Mitchell and other trout reels.

No. 1039. "MARTOGLAS" THREADLINE 7 lb. Of similar specifications as 1038 but rather more powerful, and designed for use with the Ambidex

No. 1040a. "MARTOGLAS" Solid 5 lb. STANDARD. An inexpensive two-piece 7 ft. solid glass rod with stand-off butt ring, alloy reel fittings, and domed butt cap.

No. 1040b. "MARTOGLAS" Solid 5 lb. DE LUXE. As above but with auto-lock reel fitting.

No. 1040c. "MARTOGLAS" Solid 7 lb. DE LUXE. An extremely powerful threadline rod for salmon threadlining, fitted with reinforced suction joints, stand-off metal butt rings, agatine top ring and anodised auto-lock reel fitting. Supplied in divisioned rod cover.

No. 1041. THISTLE SALMON. A best quality heavy action two piece salmon spinning rod of the same superlative finish as the Thistle fly rods. This rod has been carefully designed for use with multiplying reels such as the Gildex and has a long 24 inch solid cork handle, lockfast joints, agate butt and end rings and special reel fittings. Available in lengths of 8½ and 9½ feet.

No. 1042. CALEDONIA SALMON. An excellent quality heavy action two-piece salmon spinning rod. Of the normal Caledonia finish, but fitted with encased Agite

rings throughout, this rod is available in lengths 9 feet and 10 feet and should be used with the Freedex, Aerial or Glidex reels. (see pages 12 & 13).

No. 1043. THE PIKE. An excellent quality built cane two-piece 8 feet pike or salmon trolling rod. Fitted with adjustable reel fittings, reinforced and serrated ferrules, Agite butt and end rings and steel hoop intermediates. Suitable for use with the Freedex, Aerial or Easiecast reels. (see page 13).

Apollo Steel

No. 1044. APOLLO PAL. (see illustration page 8). The accepted leader of bait-casting rods. Finished in dark brown enamel; with best quality steel rings; the off-set handle is fitted with cork grips. The tip is secured to the handle by a positive screw locking device while the reel is also positively locked so ensuring an absolutely rigid whole which provides a delightful "feel" in use.

Alternative action tips are available—flex or medium action, length 5 feet and 5 feet 6 ins. overall.

For use with Glidex or other multiplying reels (see page 12).

No. 1045. SLAPTON, 8 feet, two piece, weight 11½ ozs. This short, lightweight, double-handed rod was developed specially for pike-spinning—it can be used throughout the day without fatigue. In spite of its light weight, many fishermen choose it for grilse and salmon fishing.

No. 1046. MULL, 8½ feet, two piece, weight 12½ ozs. A double-handed spinning rod of ample power for the heaviest pike is also much used for grilse and salmon. The

ability to cast heavy baits long distances, which is inherent in tubular steel, is seen at its best in this rod.
